The Education Initiative – “Huge” Support with Nevadans

Voters Send a Message to Carson City – Adequately Fund Education Today

(Las Vegas/Carson City, NV) –The Nevada State Education Association (NSEA) calls on legislators to sit up and take notice of a recent poll results showing “huge” support for The Education Initiative (TEI) at 58%. Noted Nevada journalist, Jon Ralston termed support as “huge” and says the poll shows “the public widely supports the margins tax.”

“Clearly Nevada’s voters recognize the importance of adequately funding our schools and see The Education Initiative as the appropriate vehicle to get that accomplished,” said NSEA President, Lynn Warne.

The survey, conducted by Republican pollster Glen Bolger for the business group Retailers Association of Nevada, also found education to be the most important issue on voters’ minds, supplanting economic issues which were of primary importance in previous polls.

“It is striking that this poll, which was conducted by a Republican pollster for a business group, shows a 20 point advantage in support of The Education Initiative. These numbers demonstrate, without doubt, that our message is resonating with Nevadans. Big business needs to pay their fair share or too many of our kids will be left behind,” said NSEA Executive Director Gary Peck.
