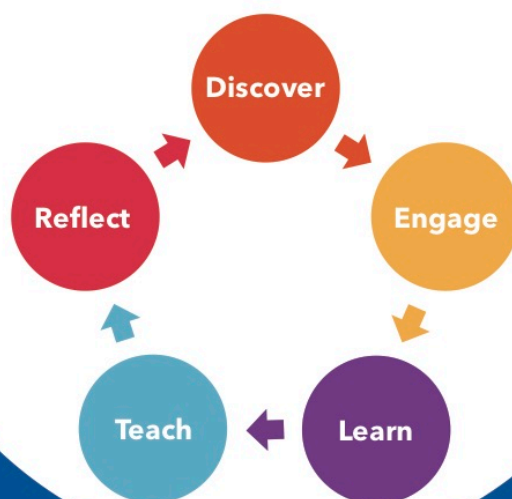


EARLY CAREER LEARNING LABS



The Early Career Learning Labs (ECLL) are a blended learning environment meant to support early career educators (ECEs) around instructional and classroom problems of practice. The ECLL program is a collaboration between the National Education Association and your local affiliate.

Early Career Educators will...

1. **Discover:** identify a problem of practice
2. **Engage:** share ideas with a national teaching community
3. **Learn:** engage in deep learning around a problem of practice
4. **Teach:** apply new knowledge techniques with your students
5. **Reflect:** share experiences and refine teaching strategies

Weekly Schedule



Week 1: Face-to-Face (90 minutes)

- Meet your local Coordinator and Early Career Educators (ECEs)
- Complete your pre-assessment and identify the Problem of Practice (POP) that your small group will work on with a Virtual Coach (VC)



Week 2: Zoom call (60 minutes)

- Local Coordinator facilitates a discussion with ECEs and Virtual Coaches
- Begin initial discussion of your POP with Virtual Coaches



Week 3: Zoom call (45 minutes)

- Meet with your Virtual Coach to review your POP and discuss your playlist of resources
- Commit to an action that you will take to address your POP



Weeks 4-8: Zoom call (30-45 minutes)

- Virtual Coach and ECEs meet to discuss POP and progress with implementing strategies
- ECEs complete reflection tools for their POPs



Week 9: Zoom call (30-45 minutes)

- Local Coordinator facilitates a face-to-face meeting
- ECEs evaluate the program and reflect over their POP cycle with their Virtual Coaches
