# Proposed Bylaw Amendments For Consideration by the 2020 Delegate Assembly



The Bylaws of the Nevada State Education Association require the organization to publish proposed bylaw amendments in the official publication of the organization in advance of their consideration at Delegate Assembly. #### **BYLAW AMENDMENT #1**

Bylaw: Article IV

Article Name: Board of Directors

Section: 12

BALLOT TITLE: EMERGENCY POSTPONEMENT/WAIVING THE HOLDING OF DELEGATE ASSEMBLY OR

**LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE** 

<u>Rationale</u>: This proposal brings NSEA in line with NEA and the ability of the Association to deal with emergencies such as a pandemic. NSEA must have the flexibility during a time of emergency to do what is in the best interest of the Association.

Bylaw: Article IV Article Name:

Board of Directors Section: 1

**BALLOT TITLE: CHANGES THE COMPOSITION OF THE NSEA BOARD OF DIRECTORS** 

<u>Rationale</u>: The bylaw allows for flexibility in whether affiliates choose to have their presidents attend, it preserves the one person one vote principle and better reflects changes in demographics of the union.

Bylaw: Article IV Article Name:

Board of Directors Section: 1

**BALLOT TITLE: AUTHORIZES NSEA TO HOLD ELECTRONIC MEETINGS/VOTING** 

<u>Rationale</u>: This amendment will allow NSEA and its entities to hold meetings and elections/voting electronically within the requirements of the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised and rules and policies established by the NSEA Board of Directors.

## **RESOLUTION #1 TITLE: School Safety**

<u>Rationale</u>: Violence against teachers is rising, but policies are increasingly keeping violent students in the classroom with teachers and students they continue to harm. We need to protect our staff and students in our classrooms.



## **RESOLUTION #2 TITLE: Student Grades**

<u>Rationale</u>: Teachers are being pressured to issue passing grades in order to boost graduation rates across the state. We need to strongly condemn this pressure and support our rights as teachers.



#### **RESOLUTION #3 TITLE: Member Voice**

<u>Rationale</u>: Local school boards make decisions which directly impact our day-to-day teaching and they would benefit tremendously from the insights of someone "on the ground" as they make these decisions.



# **NSEA Resolutions (Continued) RESOLUTION #4 TITLE: Parental Leave √** 63 SUPPORT Rationale: In many districts, mothers are forced to use sick days to recover from giving birth and fathers are offered very little parental leave at all. This is inequitable and places and undue burden on new 11 OPPOSE parents among our staff. **RESOLUTION #5 TITLE: Class Size 73 SUPPORT** Rationale: Class size are currently calculated in a way that obscures the day to day reality for most teachers. If one teacher has a class of 41 and another class of 1, it seems as if class sizes are 21. Due to 3 OPPOSE this, we need hard caps, not optimal averages. **RESOLUTION #6 TITLE: Financial Support of Public Education 74 SUPPORT** Rationale: Our current funding is woefully behind most education spending in the U.S., and these issues 1 OPPOSE must be rectified before we can attempt to fix education in Nevada. **RESOLUTION #7 TITLE: Funding Public Education 74 SUPPORT** Rationale: Our tax structure in NV is antiquated and woefully inadequate when it comes to funding our 1 OPPOSE most sacred public trust: education. We must address it before we can fix our funding issues in NV. **RESOLUTION #8 TITLE: Unfunded Mandates 72 SUPPORT** Rationale: To often we are asked to do more with less. We have to implement increasing directives without 3 OPPOSE training, increased staffing, or paper resources which strains an already overwhelmed workforce. **RESOLUTION #9 TITLE: Class Size 70 SUPPORT** Rationale: Class sizes affect not just the learning environment of the student but also the safety and mental 5 OPPOSE health of the teacher & this should be acknowledged. **RESOLUTION #10 TITLE: Salaries and Other Compensation 70 SUPPORT** Rationale: Our pay is not even keeping up with inflation or cost of living.
