Applicant must be a teacher in a public school anywhere in Nevada and in their first through fifth years of teaching. Applicant must be a member of their local association/NSEA. Scholarship monies are to be used to help finance a Master's Degree, National Boards, or for professional development training that will apply to licensure recertification or step and column advancement. The Scholarship is in the amount of \$1,000.00 and is only for that year. Scholarship funds will NOT be distributed to the applicant, but instead will be sent directly to the administrator of the program being attended. Scholarship Time Line

1. Scholarship will be presented and awarded at the April 2020 Delegate Assembly.
2. March 25, 2020 - the Scholarship Committee will meet to review the applications and select the winner.
3. March 18, 2020 - Completed applications are due into the Las Vegas NSEA office. Applications turned into the Reno office will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated or considered.
4. February 13, 2020 - Application and instructions will be published to all local presidents and Nevada NEXT. Applications will also be given to Fran McGregor and Andrea DeMichieli for distribution in the NSEA Early Educators program. Scholarship will also be published on the NSEA website.
5. February 13, 2020- Final copies of the scholarship application and instructions will be submitted to Lisa Toth.
