### **Bylaws, Rules, and Policies Committee Report to the 2026 Delegate Assembly**

The Bylaws, Rules, and Policies Committee was tasked with reviewing and updating a number of policies which were presented to the NSEA Board for consideration and adoption. The Committee reviewed and recommended to the Board of Directors changes to the following Policies (all of which were adopted):

II. Governance G. Representative Assembly to Delegate Assembly- changed the term of RA to one year.

II. Governance F. Delegate Assembly, 7- added that locals with 180 members or less may apply for financial assistance to Leadership Assembly.

The Committee reviewed and updated a policy in the Policy and Procedures Regarding the Legislative and Political Action of the Nevada State Education Association under Lobbying I- added that the presidents of NEASN, ESEA, NRE, WEA, WESP, NSEA-R, and Aspiring Educators may appoint a member from their local to serve in their place for the calendar year

The Committee worked on the following Bylaw Amendment which is being proposed by the Committee for Delegate consideration in the 2026 Delegate Assembly:

Amendment #1 – Changes the attendance policy for the NSEA Board of Directors.

II. Governance N. Instruction and Professional Development- to delete the entire section.

The Committee made editorial changes to the following Bylaws Article III Section 8 A, B and Article IV Section 12 to reflect the current name of Leadership Assembly.

The committee worked on the following Resolution which is being proposed by the Committee for Delegate consideration in the 2026 Delegate Assembly:

G. Secure Professional Autonomy to Delegate Assembly- adding charter schools to the statement about licensed professionals in all K-12 schools.
